## 2010 HUMANITARIAN SERVICE AWARD NOMINATION FORM

This award, established by the Foundation Board of Trustees in June 1997, is intended to recognize and encourage the good works and public service of the members of the Society of Former Special Agents of the FBI, Inc. The Former Agents of the FBI Foundation Board of Trustees will select one national winner to receive the Humanitarian Service Award. This winner will receive a trip to the National Convention, a plaque of recognition, \$10,000 to present to the charity of their choice and publicity in *the Grapevine* for their work and their charitable organization

Society members are encouraged to submit the names of individuals for recognition by the Foundation. Nominations will be accepted for members or spouses of members in good standing with the Society of Former Special Agents of the FBI. Qualified candidates include those who perform voluntary humanitarian services that contribute to the welfare of others through the alleviation of human suffering, the advancement of science, education and cultural arts for a sustained period of time. Individuals may be nominated in successive years so long as a new application is submitted each year. If selected to receive the award, that individual is not eligible to be nominated again for five years.
